

## SENIOR QUALITY INSPECTOR

### General Description

Cobalt Aero Services is currently seeking an experienced aviation maintenance quality assurance inspector to join our quality team. Cobalt Aero Services is a 14 CFR § 145/EASA 145 Certificated Repair Station specializing in the maintenance, repair, and overhaul of nacelle components, thrust (fan) reversers, and other aircraft structural components. The Senior Quality Inspector reports to the Chief Inspector in the performance of their duties.

### Work Experience & Certification Requirements

- 10+ years of aviation maintenance, repair, or overhaul experience. With at least 5 years in the performance of inspections. (Required)
- Current A&P License or ability to obtain Repairman's Certificate. (Required)
- Comply with DOT/FAA Drug & Alcohol testing requirements. (Required)
- Willing to work extended hours based on repair station production requirements. (Required)
- Read, write & speak English. (Required)
- Strong verbal and written communication skills. (Required)
- Possess a strong attention to detail and the ability to work independently. (Required)
- Proficient in inspections of repairs to structure in accordance with approved documentation, engineering disposition, drawings, structural repair manual or standard practices manuals. (Required)
- Familiar with composite materials and associated types of resins used in composite repairs and their applications. (Preferred)
- Able to research FAA and EASA Airworthiness Directives. (Preferred)
- Non Destructive Testing Level II in PT/MT or Eddy Current. (Preferred)
- Experience using Quantum Control or similar ERP. (Preferred)
- Proficient in the use of Microsoft Office Suite. (Preferred)
- Experience working within AS9110 and/or ASA-100 Quality systems. (Preferred)
- Previous supervisory experience. (Preferred)

### General Duties

- Perform receiving, preliminary, in-process, hidden damage and final inspections.
- Verify completion of all work orders and sign airworthiness release.
- Ensure that work is accomplished per established inspection procedures.
- Ensure that all aircraft maintenance meets FAA, customer, and company specifications.
- Ensure that inspection items are complied with properly and all necessary forms are completed.
- Maintain a thorough familiarity with the content of the company Repair Station Manual and all subsequent revisions.
- Provide initial and recurrent training to site employees.
- Remain aware of applicable CFRs, most notably Part 145, 121, 65 and Part 43.
- Perform routine surveillance of in-process work.
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.
